5	RELATING TO THE PURPOSE OF BANNING FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES FROM THE
6	USE OF WARE MADE FROM POLYSTYRENE FOAM (ALSO KNOWN AS
7	STYROFOAM); DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS; INFLICTING CERTAIN PUNISHMENTS;
8	PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESSENTIALLY RELATING TO THE
9	USE OF POLYSTYRENE PRODUCTS IN FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES.

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW
12	MEXICO GIRLS STATE:
13	"Ware" means single-use disposable products used in the restaurant, food service, and
14	food sales industries for serving, transporting, or packaging prepared, ready-

- to-consume, or uncooked food or beverages, this includes but is not limited to plates,
- 2 bowls, trays, cups, and to-go boxes.
- 3 "Food Service Facilities" means an operation that provides food for human consumption,
- 4 including but not limited to any
- 5 establishment requiring a permit to operate in accordance with the State Food Code.
- 6 "Polystyrene" means a brittle synthetic polymer composed of repeated styrene units.
- 7 Polystyrene has a wide variety of uses, especially as a solid foam for insulation and
- 8 packaging.
- 9 Food Service Facilities shall be banned from distributing/selling food or drink in disposable
- 10 containers that is made from polystyrene foam due to the environmental and health issues
- that polystyrene engenders. The environmental issues that polystyrene engenders include
- but are not limited to the endangering of wildlife, it not being biodegradable, The
- 13 Department of Sanitation concluded that expanded polystyrene cannot be recycled, despite
- the fact that many of the containers display the recycling symbol, also polystyrene sitting in
- a landfill releases methane gases. The health issues that polystyrene engenders include
- but are not limited to the fact that the styrene from polystyrene is classified as a carcinogen
- to humans according to the National Research Council, polystyrene also causes mucous
- membrane and eye irritation, and gastrointestinal effects. Polystyrene leaches into food and
- 19 drink especially when paired with liquid
- and heat, a polystyrene container's toxins (like benzene and styrene) seep into the
- contents. But even with cold or dry food, contact with polystyrene is unhealthy. A huge
- 22 portion of our food contains styrene contamination. Polystyrene is very light and crumbles
- easily, it's extremely easy for it to end up out in our woods, rivers, and prairies. Once it's
- there, it's there to stay, as it is not biodegradable. Polystyrene will break down into
- 25 microscopic styrenes and other harmful chemicals, and that will linger in the

- soil and water for years. It's an especially serious problem in our world's oceans, as fish
- 2 ingest the hazardous chemicals for styrene, which humans then ingest when eating the
- 3 fish.
- 4 Any Food Service Facility found guilty of distributing/selling food or drinks in ware made
- from polystyrene shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$5000 or by imprisonment for
- a definite term not to exceed 12 months, or both. The alternatives would instead be paper
- 7 or plastic ware to use.

- 9 All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New
- 10 Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are herby repealed.
