| 3 | Section I. Body : Within the state of New Mexico, there have been many instances where educators have been unable to perform their responsibilities to their students. Consequently, long-term substitute teachers have been called upon to take their place for lengthy periods of time. The Secondary Instructors Education Act allows the Public Education Department (PED) of New Mexico to give a teaching license to those who have a Bachelor's degree, at the minimum, in a certain field in order to take the place of the absent teacher for the time required. |

Definitions: Requirements regarding the Secondary Instructors Education Act will be as follows: candidates must have at least a bachelor's degree with three years experience in a chosen field; candidates must meet any and all requirements established by the PED of New Mexico; and, they must pass background checks with satisfactory clearance. At the end of one school year, these teachers will be allowed to repeat their teaching assignment if the students are exhibiting sustained results in their classes. |

| 12 | Section III. Penalty: The Secondary Instructors Education Act will allow vacant, long-term substitute positions to be filled by experienced and well-educated men and women. After an impressive series of qualification checks, these citizens will be allowed to fill open positions to teach New Mexico students in grades 9-12 with an anticipated resulting increase of state funds in tax revenue, as well as a decrease in New Mexico unemployment. This Act will also enable school districts to hire teachers with subject expertise and have them teach courses according to their professional degree thereby increasing student achievement. |
