Title of Bill: Cyberbullying Act of 2015

AN ACT

Relating to the concept of cyberbullying, in which perpetrator shall, along with the court-decided verdict, be fined and the funds sent to the victim. Whereas schools and technology become safer; whereas victims receive better education.

Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State that: A fine be levied on cyberbully perpetrators and the funds allocated to the victim.

Section 1. Short Title. - This act may be cited as the “yberbullying Act.”

Section 2. Definitions. - As used in the “yberbullying Act”

“A. cyberbullying”eing the chronical use of technology to harass, insult or offend another.

Section 3. Provisions. - This program would be monitored by the New Mexico Department of Justice.

A. Fines shall be paid by cyberbully perpetrators.

B. Those fines shall be given to the victim.

Section 4. Enactment. - This bill shall be enacted 30 days after its passage.
